Daylight Savings Ends – all Winter rides are now a 10 am start		
Sunday 5 th 10.00am start	Kilmore Meet at Hudson Park	Down and up this week - down Mill and Simons Hill Rds to Darraweit before returning up the Old Sydney Rd and Union Lane. Some gravel, best suited to MTB or Hybrid
Sunday 12 th No ride today	Easter Sunday	It's Easter Sunday today so no ride is scheduled. Have an Easter egg hunt with your children/grandchildren or the kids down the road instead.
Sunday 19 th 10.00am start	Wallan Meet at the Mechanics Institute Hall (Hadfield Park)	To Beveridge via Old Sydney Rd and return via Epping Rd, for a longer ride continue to Arkells Lane (gravel) then across to the Northern Highway and down the Big Hill to Wallan. Some gravel, best suited to MTB or Hybrid
Sunday 26 th 10.00am start	Seymour Meet at Seymour Cycles	Ride out the Toobarac Road to Bassetts Lane at approx 14km and turn left. Left into Bassetts Lane then left into Daisyburn Road. Turn right on reaching the Seymour Pyalong Road and return to Seymour. Total distance approx 35km. Note... Mountain or hybrid bikes with wider tyres are suggested for the gravel roads on this ride.

Sunday 3 rd 10.00am start	Kilmore Meet at Hudson Park	A tour of roads less travelled to the south-west and west of Kilmore. Some steep creek crossings, but nothing you can't walk up. Lots of gravel so best suited to MTB or Hybrids. Shorter options available
Sunday 10 th No ride today	Mothers Day	No ride scheduled for today, instead spend some quality time with your Mum
Sunday 17 th 10.00am start	Wallan (not quite) Meet in the carpark of the Malcolm Creek Learning Centre off Amaroo Dr. Craigieburn. Melways 387A5	Come and ride the Ring Road with us. A big loop from Craigieburn to Broadmeadows for a cuppa before returning along the Broadmeadows Creek path. Suitable for all types of bicycle
Sunday 24 th 10.00am start (0930 for coffee in Puckle St)	Out of Shire Ride Meet in the Moonee Ponds Station car park (in Margaret St) on the east side on the line. Melways 28H7	Still working out the finer detail, but we intend to include a river crossing on the punt and we will end up down near the beach for lunch somewhere. Return to Moonee Ponds along the Moonee Ponds Creek path. More detail closer to the event. Suited to all types of bicycle.
Sunday 31 st 10.00am start	Seymour Meet at the Seymour Post Office in Station Street	A Seymour parks tour. Come on a very casual ride to see what some of Seymour's many parks have to offer and take in some of the area's colourful history. Some gravel so MTB or hybrids recommended. Shorter options available
