



Program of events – August to September 2008

All rides commence 10.00am (winter rides)

Shorter ride options will be available for beginner and intermediate riders

August		
Sunday 3 rd 10.00am start	Kilmore Meet at Hudson Park	Zoom down the hill to Kilmore East and continue on to Wandong. Return along Saunders Rd (gravel). Short ride will return along the Wandong-Kilmore Rd. Full ride has some gravel so MTB or Hybrid recommended.
Sunday 10 th 10.00am start	Broadford Meet at "The Island" (Lions Club Park)	Ride still being planned. Check the website calendar www.mbug.org.au for details closer to the date
Sunday 17 th 10.00am start	Lancefield Meet at the MAD Gallery in High St.	Tour de bitumen. Ride to Newham through Cobaw and back along the Newham/Lancefield Rd. Suitable for all types of bicycle
Sunday 24 th 10.00am start	Out of Shire Ride – Woodlands Park Meet at 10:00am in the Boeing Reserve carpark, Boeing Rd Strathmore Heights (off Mascoma St) am Melways 16C5	Out of area ride to the Woodlands Historic Park. Loop along the Moonee Ponds Creek Trail to the Homestead and back. Mostly gravel bike paths, so MTB or Hybrids recommended
Sunday 31 st 10.00am start	Out of Shire Ride – Bendigo Meet in the carpark at the Huntly Recreation Reserve Gungurru Rd. Huntly	Come and check out the wildflowers of the Whipstick State Forest near Bendigo. Lots of gravel, so MTB or Hybrid recommended. This ride is relatively short (25km) but will take around four hours as it includes a couple of walks within the Park to give you a feel for this lovely area and it's history. Don't forget your walking shoes if you need them. Bring extra water and food as there is none available in the park.
September		
Sunday 7 th 10.00am start	Kilmore No ride today	Father's Day – No ride today. Spend the day with your family instead.
Sunday 14 th 10.00am start	Broadford Meet at "the Island" (Lions Club Park)	Springtime is here and it is an opportunity to check out the roadside flora on some of the quieter roads around Broadford. You can even include a walk up Mt Piper and look for orchids. Some gravel so Hybrids or MTB recommended. Watch for magpies!
Sunday 21 st 10.00am start	Wallan Meet at the Mechanics Institute Hall (Hadfield Park)	A pleasant loop down through Eden Park. Various options for an extended ride will be considered on the day. Some gravel so best suited to MTB or Hybrid. Road bikes can bypass the gravel by using Janna Rd (hill).
Sunday 28 th 10.00am start	Seymour Meet at the Seymour Post Office in Station St	Come along and discover some of the less-travelled (ridden) roads around Seymour. Out along Back Mountain Rd, return via Bottrills and Kobyboyn Rds. Optional shorter ride is available. Lots of gravel, so MTB or Hybrids recommended.
