Sunday 6 th 10.00am start	Kilmore Meet at Hudson Park	Cruise out the Northern Highway to High Camp and return via Willowmavin. Some gravel so best suited to MTB or Hybrids
Sunday 13 th 10.00am start	Broadford Meet at "the Island" (Lions Club Park)	Down South to Clonbinane along quiet roads, then return along the freeway for a couple of km before jumping the fence onto quieter roads again
Sunday 20 th 10.00am start	MBUG AGM Venue TBA	Our third AGM – come along and be counted. Will be held in Kilmore. Venue TBA
Sunday 27 th 10.00am start	Seymour Meet at Seymour Cycles	Another two great rides out of Seymour: 1. All bitumen out to Bassetts Rd along the Tooborac Rd and return. Easy, all bikes 2. As for Ride 1, but turn left into Bassetts Rd and return via Daisyburn, McGintys and Ashes Bridge Rds. Lots of gravel, so MTB or Hybrid recommended.
