Sunday 17 <sup>th</sup> <b>10.00am start</b>	<b>Wallan (not quite)</b> Meet in the carpark of the Malcolm Creek Learning Centre off Amaroo Dr. Craigieburn. Melways 387A5	Come and ride the Ring Road with us. A big loop from Craigieburn to Broadmeadows for a cuppa before returning along the Broadmeadows Creek path. Suitable for all types of bicycle
Sunday 24 <sup>th</sup> <b>10.00am start</b> (0930 for coffee in Puckle St)	<b>Out of Shire Ride</b> Meet in the Moonee Ponds Station car park (in Margaret St) on the east side on the line. Melways 28H7	Still working out the finer detail, but we intend to include a river crossing on the punt and we will end up down near the beach for lunch somewhere. Return to Moonee Ponds along the Moonee Ponds Creek path. More detail closer to the event. Suited to all types of bicycle.
Sunday 31 <sup>st</sup> <b>10.00am start</b>	<b>Seymour</b> Meet at the Seymour Post Office in Station Street	A Seymour parks tour. Come on a very casual ride to see what some of Seymour's many parks have to offer and take in some of the area's colourful history. Some gravel so MTB or hybrids recommended, but road bikes could cope with care. Shorter options available

Sunday 15 <sup>th</sup> <b>10.00am start</b>	<b>Broadford</b>	Quiet roads to the north-west of Broadford. A loop out Sugarloaf Creek Rd and back along Camerons Creek Rd. Shorter option available. Some gravel, best suited to MTB or Hybrid
Sunday 22 <sup>nd</sup> <b>10.00am start</b>	<b>Out of Shire Ride Lancefield.</b> Meet near the MAD Gallery in High Street Lancefield	This ride takes us out the Kyneton road to Cobaw and Newham before returning along the Woodend Road. A lovely ride suited for all types of bike.
Sunday 29 <sup>th</sup> <b>10.00am start</b>	<b>Seymour</b> Meet at the Seymour Post Office in Station Street	A picturesque loop out east of town – out along Kobyboyn Road and return via Highlands Road with a lot of downhill riding. Suitable for all kinds of bike. Shorter (gravel) options available.
