MBUG is a Bicycle Users Group located in the Mitchell Shire and serving the towns of Seymour, Tallarook, Broadford, Kilmore, Pyalong, Tooboora, Wandong, Heathcote Junction, Wallan and Beveridge.

The aims of the group are to promote cycling throughout the shire through regular organized non-competitive rides, to work with the shire to improve facilities for cyclists and provide a social outlet for cyclists.

Planned activities include workshops to teach cyclists road rules and basic bicycle maintenance. Regular organized rides to suit participants of all levels are held each Sunday, commencing at a different town each week.

Rides

MBUG has regular rides organised from the four major towns in the Mitchell Shire:

- First Sunday: Kilmore (leaving from Hudson's Park)
- Second Sunday: Broadford (leaving from "The Island" on Sunday Creek)
- Third Sunday: Wallan (leaving from the Free Library/Mechanics Hall)
- Last Sunday: Seymour (leaving from Seymour Post Office)

All rides leave at 9:00am in Summer and 10:00am in Winter and are planned to take around two hours. Rides are followed by a coffee at a local coffee shop. In general, shorter rides are offered as well as a longer ride for those wanting to go further.

For those months where there is an extra Sunday, MBUG organises a ride from one of the other towns in the Shire, e.g. Pyalong or Tallarook or an interesting Out of Shire ride.
